

So you want to be a Hang IV?

Session 1 - So you want to be a Hang IV?? I'm here to help! Safety, Spots, and Soaring will be the focus on May 18-19. We'll start out with a discussion on the evening of Friday the 18th in Redwood City and I'll share some of my best soaring strategies, deciphering the sky, decision making, approaches for consistent, safe, spot landings, and much more. The next day, Saturday the 19th, we'll be flying at Ed Levin and we'll practice these skills, fly different approaches, and sign off spot landings.

Session 2 - So you want to go XC?? The discussion on the evening of Saturday the 19th will focus on beginning cross country flying - leaving, managing altitude, picking LZs from the air, approaches and landings, hazards, and of course - soaring and safety.

The next day, Sunday the 20th, we'll meet in the morning and explore a few bailout LZs for flying XC out of Ed Levin or Mission, then we'll go fly and practice our thermal, approach, and landing skills at one of those sites, and if the weather happens to be good enough, we can go XC. Sunday night if anyone needs it we'll have a study group for the hang IV test, administer the test, and sign off any special skills or ratings.

Pilots of all skill levels welcome to attend, we'll adapt the focus according to the pilots participating.

There is no charge for anyone who would just like tasks observed on Saturday, or that would like to check out the LZs Sunday morning. Come learn something new and get the most out of this upcoming flying season!
