

There have been no accidents at the park, although there was a collision between two students on the 50 foot training hill. The burnt area is less noticeable than when it was right after the burn. Road repairs are still under discussion.

Phyl noted that the Parks Dept wont accept funds from the club because they are concerned that the club would assert legal ownership. The Parks budget has been cut. Phyl is hoping the Parks Dept will work on the road after the rains start. Carol from the Indigenous Weeds Patrol has been using herbicide in some areas of the park. Water bars are not allowed on the road. The preferred method of channeling water off the road is to construct a "rolling dip", which requires more labor but is less prone to causing erosion.


The club Christmas party was discussed. No plans were made.
