
# **SITE SAFETY & REMINDERS**

As prime flying season unfolds, consider taking time to check in with yourself - are you familiar with the current WOR site rules and procedures? Are you checking the forecast before flying, regardless of the gaggle consensus? If you have some rust to shake off, refresh your memory by checking out the site guides on the WOR website. Ask questions to your fellow pilots on launch if conditions don't match your expectations. Don't be taken by surprise just because others are confidently launching!

# **SUSPENSION REPORT**

A member was suspended from Ed Levin for 30 days for participating in flying activity after sunset. Flying activity at Ed Levin Park is permitted from opening time (8a) until one hour before sunset. The official sunset time for the day is posted on a sign at the park entrance.

"Flying activity" includes glider pack-up and breakdown, loading of equipment onto vehicles, and moving vehicles off launch access roads and out of the landing area. Pilots must not go up the hill if time will not permit them to be completely loaded up and out of the landing area in time.
