



- [Ben] President's address
 - o Things going well membership up/treasury up
 - Expect dues to go up next year in order to maintain surplus why surplus
 - No drama keep it that way

- [Tristan] Treasurer's report
 - FY2023 financial report
 - \$44,155 in the bank, +15% from 2022.
 - \$6,078 operating income, -38% from 2022.
 - \$1,252 in donations, +41% from 2022 thank you!
 - Expenses up due to: insurance rates (more than tripled), Ed Levin lawnmower purchase (again!)
 - Investing our reserve funds
 - CD rates currently very attractive (~5%)
 - Keep 1 year's worth of expenses liquid (\$10K)
 - Invest \$35K split five ways into CD ladder extending to 2028
 - Annual maturation & reinvest into 12 mo terms
 - Need board vote
 - o Insurance rates in 2024
 - Expect insurance rates to increase again by 39%
 - Likely increasing member dues in 2024










- [Evan] Secretary's report

- Site reports
 - o [Mike] Ed Levin
 - o [Steve] Mission
 - We have had a small number of incidents where the Mission Gate was locked improperly and pilots landing outside of the LZ that Park Officials have notified WOR.
 - New Gate locks were installed in late summer (Note: The Parking Lot access gate is for emergency use only)

- Mission Launch weed abatement. We have approval to use string trimmers at any time as long as we notify the park rangers of the activity
- We will be having a keyholder exchange in early 2024 (Date TBD)
- The electronic sign in and keyholder admin continues to provide an extremely valuable service to our WOR Club (Big Thank You to Bob Posey!)
- Our Mission pilot sponsors continue to expand pilot access to the Mission site (A Big Thank You! To our Mission Site pilot sponsors)
- We are re-starting a committee to acquire a weather station to be installed on our existing launch windsock (Park has already approved)
- Looking Ahead... Our Mission Permit expires in May 2025 and will require 1M in car Insurance bodily insurance coverage for keyholders

 - Flight log

 - Winner: Evan! 19 flights
 - Longest XC flight: 55km Enes to Morgan Hill, landed in same field as Evan
 - MROSD permit renewal is underway, new permits will be issued and uploaded before the end of the month.
 - Reminder about permits and signing in rangers are actively checking, but are also friendly, happy to have us there, and like watching people fly.
 - Fire abatement work was recently completed at the summit, but nothing was done to the launch slope. It's a little tight for HG, and not great for PG at the bottom with blackberries, but still in usable condition.
